



Greg Lay

February 9, 1947 - April 2, 2018

71-year-old, Greg Lay of Vandalia, Illinois, formerly of Herrick, Illinois died Monday, April 2, 2018 at 10:33 PM at St. John's Hospital, Springfield, Illinois. Funeral services will be Sunday, April 22, 2018 at 2:00 PM in Herrick Baptist Church with Pastor Jay Huddleston officiating. Inurnment will follow immediately after the service in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, Ramsey Township with Military Rites by Vandalia American Legion.

Greg Lay was born Sunday, February 9, 1947 in Rockwood, Tennessee, the son of Carl Edward and Margaret Mabel (maiden name Davison) Lay. Greg was raised in Herrick, Illinois and attended Herrick Elementary and Herrick High School with the Class of 1965. Greg Lay was a veteran of the United States Army and served in Vietnam. Greg married Patricia Mae Smith on June 1, 1984 in Herrick, Illinois. Greg Lay taught HVAC at Lake Land College and later owned and operated Lay Heating and Air Conditioning. 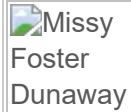
