54-year-old, Larry Blimling of Herrick, Illinois, formerly of Assumption, Illinois died Thursday, October, 5 2017 at his residence in Herrick. Cremation Rites have been accorded, funeral services will be held at graveside in New Hope Cemetery on Saturday October 28 at 10:30 am.
