Virgil Nold, 97 of Oconee, Illinois died Tuesday, March 22, 2022 at 1:10 AM at Prairie Rose Health Care Center, Pana, Illinois. Funeral services will be Thursday, March 24, 2022 at 11:00 AM in Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Oconee, Illinois with Fr. Rodney A. Schwartz officiating.
